

Minotti draws on its expertise in combining tradition and innovation in designs that are created using modern technology and finished by their skilled artisans, balancing a sharp precision with personal craftsmanship. Their experience in working with stone, and commitment to intricate craft traditions, takes shape in their creations for 2000 Ocean, which embrace a juxtaposition of textiles and leathers. Residents across all the half or full-floor units are invited to incorporate their own personal stamp onto designs that are fully customizable.

The interiors make a chic foil for the building itself: situated directly on the beach, it is brilliantly bathed in light. Enrique Norten of TEN Arquitectos and Kobi Karp, responsible for the concept design, play on the coastal location in the building's silhouette which makes a seamless outline against the landscape, with columnless corners offering unimpeded views. It is the latest in a vast portfolio for TEN Arquitectos, whose work encompasses over 60 museums, universities, hotels, public parks, libraries and residents across the world.

Landscape design by Isabel Zempel, principal designer of Sasaki, nods to these natural themes, creating verdant gardens surrounding the swimming pools and a lemon-filled mediation garden.
